Use Digital Services

Car loans can be paid through tvfcuPAY. Individuals can also open an account or apply for a loan through tvfcu.com.

Nominees for Board of Directors Announced

Your Nominating Committee has selected their nominees for the three available 3-year terms on the TVFCU Board of Directors. They are incumbents Frank Alford, Kacy Lemm and Nora Tomisek.

Frank Alford has served on TVFCU's Board since 1988 in various roles, including Board Chair. He is retired from TVA as General Manager, Contracts/Materials and is currently president and CEO of MB&A Consulting.

Kacy Lemm has served on TVFCU's Board since 2010 and is a Senior Program Manager for TVA in Information Technology.

Nora Tomisek served on TVFCU's Supervisory Committee prior to becoming a Board member in 1984 and is the current Vice Chair. She is retired from TVA as Manager of Inventory Analysis and Reporting for Supply Chain.

The election procedure will be the same as in the past several years. According to TVFCU's bylaws, if there is only one nominee for each available position, then a mail ballot will not be conducted and the nominees listed here will automatically be elected to fill the vacancies.

No nominees will be accepted from the floor at the Annual Meeting. The Credit Union does, however, allow for other nominations

In accordance with our bylaws, any member in good standing may be nominated for the Board of Directors by petition. Regulations require the petition to be signed by 1% of the membership,

up to a maximum of 500 members. Joint owners of accounts cannot be considered in the 1% total. Each member may sign a nominee's petition once. All signatures must be from members 16 years of age or older and are subject to verification by TVFCU's Supervisory Committee.

Petitions are available at TVFCU's Executive Office at 535 Chestnut Street in Chattanooga. They must be returned to the Supervisory Committee by close of business (4:45 p.m. ET) on Friday, Feb. 19, in order for the nominee to be placed on the ballot.

If a nomination by petition is received, we will hold an election and the results will be announced at our 85th Annual Meeting on Tuesday, May 4. This year's meeting will be at the Northwest Georgia Amphitheatre, 220 Catoosa Circle, Ringgold, at 7 p.m. ET. Gates will open at 6 p.m. ET.
