TVFCU Breaks Ground on New Dayton Branch

TVFCU began serving the Dayton, Tenn., community in 1986. Then the Dayton Branch was TVFCU's fourth location, aside from branches inside TVA complexes. In July, we broke ground on a new, modern free-standing branch that is closer to the center of Dayton's shopping district on Highway 27.

The branch will be more than 2,000 square feet and will have interactive teller machines in

the lobby and in the drive-thru. Employees will be on-site to help guide members' financial decisions. The drive-thru ITMs will feature personalized service from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. ET, Monday through Saturday.

The branch will be a replacement branch for TVFCU's current Dayton Branch and is on track to open in early 2020.
