

Plan Ahead for System Upgrade

Account Access Will Not Be Available During the Upgrade

As your member-owned credit union, we are continually working to make it easier for you to do business with TVFCU. That is why we have been working behind the scenes to make banking with TVFCU even better. We are currently in the process of upgrading our system. So, what exactly does this mean?

The system is the back-end software we use to support our most common transactions on the front line — like cashing checks and other branch operations — and larger tasks on the back end to support deposit, loan and credit processing capabilities. The update will allow adoption of cutting-edge technology that will provide you with an enhanced member experience.

While the bulk of the upgrade will take place in the background, there will be times that it will impact some of the services you may use. Our priority throughout this process is to limit the impact on our members. One way we will do this is by communicating with you frequently to ensure you are informed. To receive these communications, it is important that we have your most recent contact information on file.

Ensure Contact Information is Up-to-Date

Please log in to tvfcuONLINE (click "Settings" and then

"Profile"), call us at (423) 634-3600 or visit your local branch to make sure your mailing address, email and phone numbers on file are correct. We want the upgrade to go as smoothly as possible, and will frequently share important information.

Look for the System Upgrade Logo

To make them easier to identify, all upgrade-related communications will have the TVFCU System Upgrade logo.

Plan Ahead for Scheduled Maintenance

The system upgrade will require scheduled maintenance windows

when some of our account access systems may be unavailable. You will not be able to access your TVFCU account from 7 p.m. ET on Friday, April 29, until Monday, May 2. You can still use your TVFCU ATM and debit cards, but access may be limited. TVFCU credit cards will not be impacted during the system upgrade.

Use the "Shop Local. Save Local." feature of TVFCU Perks Checking Account app to save on dinner from an array of restaurants.

- Create a week's menu and shopping list, and plan for leftovers.
- Shop at discount stores and buy generic
- Cut back on eating out and take your lunch to work.
- Order water when eating out and save on those expensive drinks.

3. Save on Clothing

- Shop at consignment and thrift shops, especially for growing children's
- Sell old clothing at garage sales or consignment shops.
- Learn to make simple clothing repairs.
- Welcome hand-me-downs.

4. Save on Transportation

- Use public transportation or carpool if possible.
- Drive vehicles that get good gas
- Plan to make limited trips instead of making several trips to run errands.

5. Save on Miscellaneous

- Make gifts instead of buying gifts.
- Explore free entertainment venues, such as parks, playgrounds and hiking
